

Attention Class and Open Studio Participants

- **Most importantly, welcome to the WAA Gallery. Have fun, learn and grow and create to your hearts content!**
- Please be mindful of the environment around you: We have visitors who come to the gallery to see the art on the walls while you are here. Please make sure your set up leaves plenty of room for visitors to get around you to view the art.
- You may use the gallery's easels, which are located in the storage room next to the bathroom. *When you are finished*, the easels **must** be put back neatly and **cleaned** if wet with paint.
- Clean up for your brushes is to be done in the back boiler room behind the kitchen in **the utility tub only**. No clean up should occur in the kitchen or bathroom sinks.
- Oil painters must use fragrance free products and stay clear of highly toxic chemicals being brought into the gallery. Tops and lids should be kept on your solvents and paint thinners to keep the air as chemical free as possible. Weather permitting please keep the doors or windows open to circulate the air. Use the ceiling fan during painting.
- Extra tables are stored in the boiler room and may be used. All tables used must be washed down/wiped off from any wet or dry paint or art supplies used during classes. Please check the floor and your surroundings to make sure you have not missed anything. Paper towels are in the boiler room high on a shelf to the left of the door. These are for clean-up only, please bring your own for personal use.
- All tables used must be neatly placed back where they belong next to the refrigerator and being careful not to bump into the pipes nearby.
- All trash that contains rags or paper towels which have chemicals on them must be taken to the dumpster after class or open studio.
- You may store your lunch in the refrigerator and use the kitchen as long as you clean up afterwards.
- Extra chairs may be used but must be put back exactly the same way: facing down, head towards the wall. They are located in the storage room next to the bathroom.
